

I hope everyone had a wonderful March and enjoyed March Break. I've been hearing stories about all of the exciting adventures the kids had over the break.

Ms. Lyn recently introduced me to a wonderful organization that she's volunteering with called the *Nanny Angel Network*. I had the opportunity to speak with their Manager of Volunteer Engagement and Community Partnerships, Lorna Catrambone who provided some more information for anyone interested in getting involved:

The Nanny Angel Network (NAN) is the only not-for-profit organization of its kind in Canada. The Nanny Angel Network provides free specialized in-home relief childcare for mothers who have been diagnosed with cancer, requiring palliative care, and for families requiring additional relief during the bereavement period. When a mother is diagnosed with cancer often her first thoughts are around her children. Wondering who will care for them and how they will manage through the upcoming challenges. The Nanny Angel Network works to provide that support to mothers and their families by providing 4 hours of relief childcare each month through a Nanny Angel volunteer who is paired with the family based on their unique circumstance. Nanny Angel volunteers are childcare professionals, rigorously vetted to provide care during this difficult time. With specialized training, Nanny Angels help assure parents that their children are in safe, caring and qualified hands. This allows the mothers to focus on their treatments and get some rest during this physically and mentally exhausting time.

Children find comfort in the caring and informed support Nanny angels provide, helping them navigate, grieve and ultimately thrive in the face of the overwhelming complexities associated with a mother's cancer diagnosis.



Registration for the 2018/2019 school year has opened up to new students and a space cannot be guaranteed unless post-dated cheques have been provided for the year.

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Waiting List

First off, we'd like to extend a huge thank you to all of the wonderful parents who have been spreading the word about *The Greenwood Schoolhouse*! Many of our classes have filled up and we've begun a waiting list for some time slots. If your child is a current student and you would like put them on the waiting list to add more days, please notify us via email. They will be added to the waiting list and you will be notified when a space becomes available.

For future students: There is no fee to be put on the waiting list. In order to be added to the waiting list, we ask that parents complete the registration packet and submit a cheque for the \$125 Registration Fee but this cheque will not be deposited until:

1. A space becomes available.
2. The space is accepted.

When a space becomes available, you will be notified via email. You will have 48 hours to decide whether you would like to accept the space. If yes, the registration fee cheque will be deposited and you will provide the post-dated monthly cheques. If no, you may retrieve your cheque and will not be charged. After 48 hours, we will move to the next person on our list.

If you would like to remove your child's name from the waiting list, please notify us via email and you can retrieve your cheque. Thanks!



Jump-In Classes

Some parents have expressed interest in flexible programming (similar to how we do registration during the summer time where you just register your child for days where you know they're free). We have a limited number of jump-in spaces available for some of our classes. If you would like to register your child for individual days of extra-curricular programming or add on individual days in our Pre-K/Kindergarten program, get in touch to discuss availability.

What to bring each day

Please send your child to school with a full change of clothes and wipes each day. We have lots of fun and fun can get messy so sometimes even the older children will need to change because of paint and water spills. Please also send a pair of indoor shoes or slippers that may be left at the school. Snack and water is provided.



Separation Anxiety

Starting school can be both exciting and daunting for children and parents alike. Separation anxiety is not uncommon and we're committed to ensuring that your child has a happy, smooth transition into our programs. What you can do to help: Little ones can sense parents' anxieties. If you approach their first experience at school with confidence and positivity it will much easier for them to feel comfortable and secure. We recommend giving your little one a big hug and saying "See you later!" and then departing. Any hesitancy and lingering on a parent's part can make the process take longer and makes it difficult for teachers to get into the routine (which becomes familiar, comfortable and fun!). We will communicate with you about how your child's day was and together come up with strategies to ensure a happy experience.

What is "Show and Share"?

Each month, Pre-K, JK and SK students in our *Academic Enrichment* program have a special day scheduled that is their "Show and Share" day. The date will be emailed to you. This is your child's first opportunity to become comfortable speaking to a group. Children are encouraged to bring a favourite story (they needn't be able to read it independently but try to pick one that they are familiar enough with to re-tell in their own words), or a special memento or photo from a family trip or exciting day. These types of items tend to encourage dialogue and provide a wonderful way to create connections between home and school. On your child's "Show and Share" day they are welcome (but not required) to bring a snack to share with their classmates (nut-free please).
